Expected hours - 10 hours per week from May 4th to first summer fruits, usually 3rd or 4th week of June, then at least 20 hours with a maximum of 30 hours depending on summer weather from July to October 1st.

Pay - 15\$ per hour, \$150.00 per week early season, maximum pay \$450.00 per week during peak season

Expected duties -

- Trellis and train tomatoes to a single stem
- Harvest tomatoes, peppers, zucchini, cucumbers, melons, squash
- Label retail packages, sort and package fruits.

Flexible Hours - Training tomatoes can be done any day, once per week. Harvest and packaging must be done Sunday, Monday or Tuesday for Wednesday morning delivery.

Gain Experience with State and Federal Regulations and Compliance, Retail labeling and UPC management, Third party certification processes like Organic, Sustainable, Grass fed ect.
